

STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT
FOR TRANSPORTED SEMEN AND/OR ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION
THE COLOURED COB GYPSY HORSES

This STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT for the breeding season of 2013, is made and entered into on _____ by and between Valerie Menz of THE COLOURED COB, Stallion Owner and _____ hereinafter designated Mare Owner. Mare Owner agrees to breed the mare _____, Reg. No. _____ to the Stallion, **Black Forest Romeo**, GHRA #00000506, for the fee of \$ _____, for a live foal, subject to the following conditions:

1. **The entire stud fee, which includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$200.00 is due with this signed contract before semen is released and/or shipped. The Stallion collection fee of \$250.00 is also due at this time.** Well in advance of semen shipment, it is imperative that Mare Owner and The Coloured Cob agree upon a mutually convenient breeding date so that the stallion will be available for collection. Once viable semen is shipped to the Mare Owner, or his/her agent, the stud fee is non-refundable. If additional shipments are required to settle the mare, an additional \$250.00 collection fee will be charged, due prior to release and/or shipment.
2. Stallion Owner agrees that if said stud fee is paid, and said mare, as a result of this breeding, does not have a live foal that can stand and nurse unassisted, the stud fee will be carried forward to the next breeding season ONLY. If the mare miscarries or aborts, Mare Owner has the privilege to a rebreeding during the current season or the following year ONLY. Thereafter, this contract will be deemed fulfilled. Once a live foal has been delivered, assisted or unassisted, that can stand and nurse unassisted, this contract is deemed fulfilled. Stallion Fee will not be refunded.
3. The stud fee will be carried forward, and the live foal guarantee is valid, only if the Mare Owner has properly maintained the health of the mare, and verifies the mare's pregnancy loss, stillbirth or newborn foal death by notifying the Stallion Owner by phone within 48 hours and sending a signed and dated veterinary certificate within 14 days, clearly stating the following:
 - a. Identification of the mare named herein
 - b. Verification of the loss of pregnancy or stillbirth
 - c. Verification that, in the veterinarian's best judgment, the mare was maintained in a reasonable state of health, including vaccinations and deworming and that monitoring of the mare at time of foaling was adequate enough to reasonably detect and attend to any foaling difficultiesIf Mare Owner fails to deliver the mare for rebreeding the following year, then any and all fees paid shall not be refundable; the right to rebreed is thereby cancelled and the Stallion Owner is released from any further obligation whatsoever.
4. If the mare is registered, a copy of her papers must accompany this contract to expedite completion of the stallion report. Mares must be in healthy and sound breeding condition. A health record of deworming, vaccinations and clean culture (except maidens), must be provided to The Coloured Cob prior to semen shipment.
5. A Stallion Certificate will be issued for a foal when all expenses have been received in full by The Coloured Cob, the mare has produced a live foal that stands and nurses by this mating, and Mare Owner requests it.

6. Before semen will be shipped for a mare to be bred by transported semen, Mare Owner must pay the transported semen deposit as outlined on the fee schedule, will be deducted from the deposit and the remaining balance returned when no more shipments are needed for the current breeding season. SHOULD MULTIPLE SHIPMENTS EXCEED THE DEPOSIT ON THE ACCOUNT, A FURTHER DEPOSIT MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE COLOURED COB BEFORE ANY FURTHER SHIPMENTS ARE MADE.
7. Mare Owner understands that Val Menz of THE COLOURED COB GYPSY HORSES, must be notified the first day that said mare comes into season. 570-460-6473. Call again twenty-four to forty-eight hours before you will need stallion collected. Federal Express Overnight Service will be used in most cases.
8. It is further agreed that should the above named stallion die or become unfit for service after the mare is pronounced safely in foal, the Stallion Owner is released from all further responsibility. It is further agreed that should the stallion die, be sold by the owner, or become unfit for service, prior to settling the mare, that \$_____ of the breeding fee will be refunded, if it has been paid in full, thereby cancelling this entire contract; or, if mare dies or becomes unfit to breed, the Stallion Owner has the option to either (a) accept another mare as a replacement or (b) refund \$_____ of the breeding fee, if it has been paid in full, thereby cancelling this Contract.
9. The Mare Owner hereby grants license and permission to the Stallion Owner to photograph the mare and any get of the above mentioned for promotional purposes. The Stallion Owner may identify the mare and the Mare Owner in the event said promotion is engaged.
10. The Mare Owner hereby certified that he, she, or it is the actual owner of record of the mare and has all power and authority to enter into this particular agreement for the mare in question.
11. This Contract is non-assignable and non-transferable.
12. This Contract is entered into the State of New Jersey and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of that state. If any clause in this Contract is against State Laws, then that clause shall be null and void.
13. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreements or promises, verbal or implied are included unless specifically stated in this written Contract. Additional conditions should be individually initialed by each party. If none, check box [].

When Mare Owner and Stallion Owner sign this Contract, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.
